What is Vertical Rod Panic Bar For Emergency Doors?

A Surface Vertical Rod (also known as a panic bar, exit device, panic device, crash bar, or a push bar) is a form of lever tumbler lock for unlocking a door during emergency conditions.

The mechanism consists of a spring-loaded metal bar fixed horizontally to the inside of an outward-opening door.

What is vertical rod?

Vertical Rod Panic Device Basics. A Vertical Rod Panic Device has rods that connect the device's pushpad to the top and/or bottom latches. Since the strikes are mounted on the top of the door frame and the floor, it allows for two latch points and many choose this type of exit device for the added security.
